

## CLERK'S REPORT COUNCIL MEETING 11<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2024

### 1. Public Speaking

The Clerk noted the information provided from the film crew that there is a blanket ban on donations. It has not been possible to make arrangements for any funds to be provided to the village in relation to this particular film.

### 2. Planning

As instructed, an objection to planning consultation 24/00833/FUL, was submitted.

### 3. Reports from Outside Bodies

#### **Village Green Committee**

The clerk has distributed posters advertising the Christmas Lights switch on and raffle. Details have also been included on the website and social media.

#### **Middleton School Governors**

The clerk has made a request to DCC for the road markings to be repainted, as requested.

### 4. Streetscene Issues

- The Clerk has made contact with DCC Highways to discuss the parking issues on Main Street and speeding issues, and a meeting is to be arranged.

### 5. Vehicle Speed Related Issued

The Clerk is in communication with DCC regarding placement of the 20s Plenty banners at Rise End.
